Rules & Regulations

1. Limit of three (3) art pieces
(properly framed with wire)
2. Art pieces are to be plainly labeled with the enclosed name cards
(placed on the bottom right hand corner)
3. If you are a new member, the cards will be provided on Exchange Day
4. Art pieces must remain at Pinecrest Manor until the next Exchange Day, which will be announced in the future, **EXCEPT**, if your art pieces are sold between the exchange periods. If this is the case, you must **RECORD** the sale and your replacement piece on your personal page in the Aspiring Artist Binder located at the front desk of Pinecrest Manor *(blue binder with Aspiring Artist logo on the cover)*
5. All new members must sign a Release Form, which will be provided
6. Please place your name on the **back** of your art piece. A return address label works great
7. No "Paint by Number" pictures will be accepted

There is no fee to become a member of the Aspiring Artist Program. Call the ECCOTA gallery for more information at 772-7051.

This program allows artists to display art pieces free of charge. The art is enjoyed by residents, staff, visitors, relatives, friends, and the general public all day long, seven days a week.

*If you replace a painting/photo before the Exchange Day, please replace with the same size picture or smaller if possible.
